Rare Automobiles Showcased at Corona del Mar State Beach

Linda Leonhard, President of the Corona Del Mar Chamber of Commerce, today announced that the 4th Annual Coastline Car Classic has sold out the field of select Classic, vintage and custom cars set to be on display Sunday, September 9, 2007 at the world-class Big Corona Del Mar State Beach location. Leonhard said, "We are proud to showcase a selection of cars that have never before been seen in southern California and the caliber of these automobiles is exceptional. Also, the response we have had is the best we have seen in the three year history of the show."

This year's field of cars include several unique and prestigious automobiles from some of the finest collections in southern California. Visitors will be able to view the Howard Hughes, all original, 1954 Chrysler New Yorker. This automobile has 1,600 original miles, made specifically for Mr. Hughes with a special air filtration system, similar to what the Hughes Corporation did for its airplane construction. On display from the Art Astor Collection will be a 1938 Cadillac V16, once owned by Gary Cooper, and a very unique 1941 Chrysler Town and Country "Barrel Back" woody – one of only a few left on the road today. From the collection of Ed Berchman, there will be a 1937 Lincoln Derham Sport Sedan, winner at Pebble Beach, Rodeo Drive and Newport Beach Concours.

Probably the most unique automobile entered in the show is a magnificent, one of a kind, 1928 Mercedes Town Sedan, built especially for Alice Busch of the Anheuser-Busch family by the Murphy Body Company of Pasadena. This automobile has not been on display in over 20 years.

For those interested in exotic sports cars, a sleek and beautiful 2001 Lamborghini Diablo 6.0, recently voted Best of Show at the 2006 Concorso Italiano at Pebble Beach, will also be highlighted.

The field of judged cars includes, Pre-War American and Classic Cars, Corvettes, Post War American, Woodies, Muscle Cars, Hot Rods and Customs, Post War Foreign cars, Exotic Sports Cars and specialty entrants. There will be live entertainment, food and beverages along with many unique vendor presentations.

Ms. Leonhard said, "This year there is something for everyone. It will be a great day for families to enjoy beautiful cars, the wide array of food offered and the beauty of Corona Del Mar State Beach."
